### QUALITY POLICY

The Department of Veterinary Medicine and Animal Production (DMPVA), as part of its organizational strategy, promotes teaching, research and the third mission. The Department guarantees teaching and research activities, established by its Governing Bodies and envisaged in the three-year Departmental Strategic Plan for development. - ✓ Monitoring of research products and public engagement activities;
- ✓ Adoption of appropriate measures for improvement.
